

In Conversation with **LUCRECIA DALT**

Berlin-based Colombian singer-songwriter **Lucrecia Dalt**—whose work bridges experimental sound, avant-garde art, poetic songwriting, speculative fiction, and Latin American popular traditions—will visit Baltimore to mark the release of her new album, *A Danger to Ourselves* (2025), with a concert at Current Space.

At Hopkins, Dalt will join Prof. Marcelo Nogueira (MLL) for a conversation about her poetics and creative process, her discography, the new album, and the broader intersections of sound, culture, and literature in her work.

The discussion will take place alongside a curated **listenig session** of tracks from her albums, played directly from **vinyl records**.
