SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES IN THE NATURAL SCIENCES, MATHEMATICS, AND ENGINEERING

The Goldwater Scholarship supports outstanding students interested in research careers in the natural sciences, mathematics, and engineering. **The scholarship covers undergraduate eligible expenses for tuition, fees, books, and room and board up to \$7,500 per academic year for up to 2 years.**

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for nomination, a student must:

- Have a minimum of one semester and no more than two years of undergraduate study remaining beginning September 2022.
- Be pursuing a bachelor's degree on a full-time basis*.
- Have an average GPA > 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Have a demonstrated interest in a research career in the natural sciences, mathematics, or engineering.
- Be nominated by his or her college or university via the official online nomination application.

*As a result of COVID-19, some students may not be enrolled full-time during the 2021-2022 academic year. Schools may nominate these students as part of the 2022 Goldwater competition.

HOW TO APPLY

To apply to be a JHU nominee in the 2022 Goldwater Scholarship competition, **please submit a pre-application by November 8 at 9am ET**. Details are on the JHU National Fellowships Program (NFP)'s Blackboard site for Goldwater applicants.
